Flex your creativity

Do the carrot cake dance with *Lyla in the Loop*: Bake a carrot cake with your child by following the steps of this recipe together. Then, watch a clip from *Lyla in the Loop* and learn the carrot cake dance! This activity is available in English and Spanish.

Step it out with *Work it Out Wombats*: Play this <u>digital game</u> to help your child use creative thinking to make and test sequences! Discover different ways to make a sandwich, build a sand castle, and more!

Encourage collaboration
